2013-2014 Goals

- *Participating patrols submit new MOU, Annual Accounting of CC Funds, and Regional accounting to Division Treasurer for timely distribution of funds.

- *Transition between coordinators in the FWD and new contact at SBRPSTC.
- *Re-establish annual contract with Columbia College renewed 7/1/2013 for 2013-2014.
- *The CA State Budget: no guarantees, but the FWD will proceed as if there will be a program. The cost per unit could increase (unknown as of 6/2013).
- *Enroll candidates in 125 hour class: ESR, MLR, Southern, Northern (?)
- *Enroll patrollers in 28 hour class: at least the same as last year.
