Four of five regions ID program seems strong. AZ in need of support / ideas / communication. No course activity in past several years.

15 ID Courses Offered, 106 Students completed ID.

1 ID Instructor Course offered, 8 new ID Instructors appointed.

1 New ID IT Appointed.

ID Instructor Refresher offered in Davis to 115 patrollers and instructors.

New NSP Inst. Development (ID) Textbook ready for printing and posting.

NEW ID Instructor Manual in review at this time.

28 ID Instructors in FWD, 6 are Inst. Trainers.

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**GOALS FOR COMING SEASON:**

Introduction of new ID textbook (now in pre-press) and updates for ID Instructors relating to new textbook.

Introduction of new ID Instructor Manual (now in production) and updates for ID Instructors and ID ITs relating to new Instructor Manual.

Ascertain ID needs of each of the 5 Regions relating to courses and instructor needs, particularly Arizona which has been almost inactive in terms of offering ID courses.

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**ISSUES and RESOLUTIONS:**

Major record-keeping problems at NSP, courses being lost or never received, and I am not receiving notification of courses being registered and taught. Completed courses drop off my report (including my own) which makes this report very hard to fill out accurately.
