SEASON HIGHLIGHTS — total classes — total participants
~60% of the Certified Clinics were cancelled due to resort closure.

The Certified Committee met in Jan 2014 in Denver to continue development of the Classification Study Guide. A successful meeting, followed up with monthly conference calls to complete the Guide and a 10th hour add to define a program guide. The committee was tasked with an expansion of project with a firm deadline for Summer '14 presentation to the Education Committee.

An initial review was presented to the Division Directors in mid July. DD feedback allows the Committee to tune the Guide further and August presentation seems firm.

GOALS FOR COMING SEASON:

- Continue the bridge building across NSP Divisions with compromise from all Divisions and educating all Divisions of the similar efforts and passion for the classification across the NSP.
- Introduce the Classification Study Guide across the NSP organization.

ISSUES and RESOLUTIONS:

- Earn approval from the Division Directors followed by Education Committee to support the Certified Classification Study Guide.
- Roll out via the Division Supervisors / Representatives and begin the feedback integration process. Constant evaluation will provide a stronger guide and ensure stake holders support the efforts of the committee.

Far West will continue the close relationship of training and patroller education with the APP. This tandem effort presents a unique opportunity for patroller interaction. FWD will continue foster strong ties and cross training.
