SEASON HIGHLIGHTS — total classes — total participants

- Coordinator responsibilities successfully transferred from nancy Stromswold to Tom Taylor
- Registered 4 OEC Classes (125 Hour) representing 41 students for 13-14 season
- Registered 17 Refresher Classes/patrols (28 Hour) representing 561 Students for 13-14 season
- Financial information about total \$ paid to various patrols and FWD available from Keith Dickens

GOALS FOR COMING SEASON:

- Better tracking and timely submission of annual accounting and signed MOU's
- Minimum of 45-60 day advance notice for class registration to guarantee that CCP will successfully register and enroll all submitted student enrollment forms
- Increase patrol participation by 2-3 patrols
- Improve communication and understanding of FWD/NSP from CCP contact

ISSUES and RESOLUTIONS:

- Due to Community College registration limits and internal administration issues at CCP, we had 4 patrols representing 228 students (28 hour class) not get enrolled for 13-14 season. (despite the fact that they submitted their paperwork on time). This will potentially result in a 31% decrease in patrol and FWD funding for this season. Will need to adjust payouts to patrols to reflect the reduction in accepted enrollments and not penalize the 4 patrols.
- Going forward we'll increase the lead time that patrols must report and register their summer OEC (125 hours) and fall refresher (28 hour) classes.
