SEASON HIGHLIGHTS — total classes — total participants

We currently have registered a total of 88 Transportation courses in the FWD. Course types are as follows:

PAT = 20 / TREF = 24 / RECAL/REALP = 9 (Instructor Recertification events)

Senior events = 16 (includes SATE, SASE, SAET, and SAEE) / TES = 9 / SES = 6 / SESB = 2

STW = 3 Please note this includes both course registration duplicates (appx. 23%) and courses later cancelled due to conditions.

Breakdown By Region is as follows: ESR 37 / SCA 32 / MLR 9 / AZ 8 / NCA 1

GOALS FOR COMING SEASON:

Register 110 Transportation courses in the FWD this season.

ISSUES and RESOLUTIONS:

Course registration duplication issue arose when an IOR completes the online course registration process; each time the "submit" button is pushed, a new course is registered. With a 30 second + delay in processing the course, many instructors hit "submit" two or three times, effectively registering the same course multiple times, resulting in extra work for the Program Supervisor, Administrators, IORs, and National Office staff to confirm the duplication and cancel the extraneous courses.

Instructor expiration dates. Although instructor renewals were submitted on time by FWD staff, the updated expiration dates are being replaced with the old expiration dates upon the input of patrol registration data. Unknown causation.
