SEASON HIGHLIGHTS — total classes — total participants

14-15 Season.....Registered 8 OEC /125 hour classes representing 70 students; Registered 14 OEC classes (28 hour) representing 642 students; Received 100% of MOU's: Most CCP payments issued to patrols by the end of the 3rd quarter 2014. Still a level of misunderstanding from Southern CA patrols re the process....related to their recent participation in the CCP program: Appears that we received funding for all enrolled classes this year. (recall that last season, about 20% of our classes were not enrolled); Lost at least one patrol in the program (Boreal) due to the perception of a lot of administrative work for very little return. This concern is shared by quite a few patrols. Rumors circulating that So Ca patrols may be interested in pursuing their own contracts with local community colleges in So CA.

GOALS FOR COMING SEASON:

- -125 hour OEC class- 10 classes representing 100 students
- -28 hour Refresher class- 20 classes representing 700 students
- -Timely submission of class schedules and enrollments to South Bay Regional
- -100% acceptance by CCP of submitted classes
- -14/15 CCP payments distributed to patrols by end of Q3 2015
- -Find replacement CCP Coordinator by 7/1/2016

ISSUES and RESOLUTIONS:

- -So Ca Patrol education and rumors they want to do their own contract......FWD Board will need to be aware and engage So Ca leadership.
- -Timely payments to patrols.....several patrols/regions still don't submit their financial reports as requested, causing delays......continue to educate
- -Perception of too much admin work relative to return....just need to continue to educate
- -Replacement CCP Coordinator.....work with FWD Board to identify potential candidates.
