SEASON HIGHLIGHTS TO DATE: With little to no snow at elevation below 7,000ft. It has been another difficult season in Northern California.

Mt. Shasta ski park was open for a total of 24 days. Most likely not to reopen this year! Last month snowpack at 8500' on the main mountain was 120% of average. Unfortunately the ski area sits between 5500' and 6850' (Too High of snow levels ☹)

Coppervale (5500' to 6300') and Lassen (10,463' at peak) are in low snow as well year as well with the exception of upper backcountry mountain on Lassen.
