SEASON HIGHLIGHTS — total classes — total participants

We registered a total of 125 Transportation Courses in the Division in 2016, just slightly below our all time high of 133 in 2013 - a significant rebound from the drought peak years. Those courses included:

- 6 Instructor Continuing Education events
- 35 Toboggan Refreshers
- 17 Patroller 101 courses
- 26 Senior events (13 ski, 13 toboggan)
- 38 Enhancement events (27 toboggan, 9 ski/board)

Cumulative anticipated registration for these events was 1862 FWD patrollers.

GOALS FOR COMING SEASON:

- Attend SoCA ICE event
- Early season Dodge Ridge OET Region Administrator clinic.
- Develop new AZ Region OET Administrator.
- Instructor Trainer support and verification of assigned duties.

ISSUES and RESOLUTIONS:

Data base breakdowns in Lakewood still present a significant barrier to continued development of the Transportation Program nationally. The new course offerings recently created by the Transportation Committee, along with the descriptions of those courses, remain largely invisible to the NSP membership.

Lack of access to certain reports, notably delinquent courses, has once again handcuffed Division Program Supervisors from being effective in their required duties.

A resolution may be available late season 2016 if IT development in Lakewood remains on the new adjusted /revised track. Or not.
