SEASON HIGHLIGHTS TO DATE — total classes — total participants

- Registered 2 OEC classes (125 hour) representing 18 students
- Registered 12 Refresher classes (28 hour) representing 517 students

SEASON GOALS:

- 1) Maintain 14-15 class enrollment levels in 15-16.....will not accomplish....125 hour OEC classes have dropped from 8 classes/70 students to registered to 2 classes/18 students registered due to fewer OEC class offerings in CA and lack of qualified TI's. Reduction in one 28 hour class and approx 50 students due to Shasta Patrol deciding not to participate.
- 2) Work with FWD Treasurer to assure timely (no later than 4th qtr) payments to participating patrols- accomplished
- 3) Identify qualified patroller to replace Tom Taylor as FWD CCP Coordinator by may 2016- Accomplished subject to FWD board approval of recommended candidate. Board Action required....see below.

ISSUES and RESOLUTIONS:

- CCP program growth from 2012 to 2015 was primarily due to the addition of Southern California patrols....specifically, two large patrols- Bear and Snow Summit. My recommended replacement in Southern CA, Steve Thorsted should be able to facilitate continued growth. However, a reduction in patrol size in Northern CA and a lack of interest in Northern CA will limit overall growth potential. The administration effort required relative to funds received is not as attractive as in the past. In addition, we saw a large drop in OEC class offerings in Northern CA this year.

-CCP Coordinator replacement.....I am recommending that Steve Thorsted, Snow Summit be approved as my replacement. Steve is our longest serving Southern CA CCP Supervising Instructor. He has been a strong advocate of the program and has been instrumental in helping expand CCP within other Southern CA patrols. His knowledge of the program, strong organizational/communication skills and the fact that he has expressed an interest in this position make him the ideal candidate.
