SEASON HIGHLIGHTS TO DATE — total classes — total participants

It is difficult to track courses since there is no access to course reports on my education page. My best guess from courses assigned to me is 4 ID classes with 28 students and 2 IDICE courses with 105 students in 4 of our 5 regions, including two courses in Arizona which hasn't had any courses in years. I travelled to Arizona last season to mentor a new instructor and IT and recert an existing instructor so they could activate their ID program once again.

I have just submitted my fourth article to Candace for Ski Patrol magazine for her consideration. My last three articles were included in the last three magazines.

The new Instructor Development Continuing Education Course which I was asked to produce has now been approved by the National ID Committee and our National Education Director and is now the global template for offering CE Courses for any NSP education discipline. The manual is now posted on all instructors education pages.

I am working with the National ID Committee on the redesign of the on-line ID course. We have set a goal of April 1, 2016 to have a beta test version up and running on the NSP web site.

SEASON GOALS:

- Continue to ascertain ID needs of each of the 5 Regions relating to courses and instructor needs.
- Continue my work with the National Instructor Development Committee on several active projects we are working on for ID, including the revised on-line course, ID Instructor Manual Update, and Continuing Education Course Implementation.
- Help to distribute the Continuing Education Model and Template to all FWD Instructors of all disciplines and solicit their input and comments.
- To try to produce an ID article for every issue of Ski Patrol Magazine.
