SEASON HIGHLIGHTS — total classes — total participants

Clinics - Six attended by over 40 NSP members in Arizona and California

Arizona had ~20 attending

S-Cal Region trainings had ~ 30 attending

APP Clinics had ~20 attending

One FWD patroller completed training Ron Winkleman of Mt Shasta

Seven patrollers from other Divisions attended Flagstaff training and completed Certified training. One from Central Div and two from Intermountain Division. The intermountain division patrollers are significant as one is now the Division Supervisor and both are already kick starting interest and training

GOALS FOR COMING SEASON:

- 1) Increase participation in Certified trainings and Clinics.
- 2) Create a process to capture training of Certified Candidates training at APP clinics
- 3) Add 4-6 to NSP Certified classification.
- 4) Ensure NSP IT attending all Certified Clinics - compliance with NSP Policy

ISSUES and RESOLUTIONS:

- 1) Capture training into the NSP Education system of NSP members at APP events. --
- 2) Training for instructors, and members attending APP clinics. Create a checklist for reference, and ideally get at least a sign up list, prefer computer access for course sign up at time of testing for each NSP member.
- 3) Celebrate success via Region Advisors
- 4) Request IT sign up for each clinic, ideally 2-3 IT's attend to test or give tests and monitor test quality.
