Turned in paperwork for a new class Patrolling 101. At this time the class has not been approved nor disapproved. No addition paperwork for the class has been requested. Community College has not responded to status requests. Estimated income for next season should nearly equal OEC classes.

GOALS FOR COMING SEASON:

Refresher classes: Increase enrollment to 90% at each participating patrol.

 Add one additional patrol to the program

OEC: Increase participation to 9 of all OEC classes in Division.
