SEASON HIGHLIGHTS — total classes — total participants

1. Organized & ran Eastern Sierra Region 20th Annual Heavenly women’s clinic, Feb. 26, 2017--19 attended, 4 TI’s
2. Was IT/TI and attended MotherLode Region Women’s Clinic at China Peak, CA in March 4-5--12 attended, 2 TI’s
3. Attended Women’s Summit at Mammoth CA, March 5-9. Instructed in 2 clinics--4 attended; attended 2 other ski clinics
4. Attended Powderfall, Snowmass, CO, April 3-10. Instructor for 2 clinics--10 attended each.
5. Now have a full complement of region women’s advisors--5 regions, 5 advisors
6. Have selected, will mentor and asked someone to be my replacement when I retire from ski patrol

GOALS FOR COMING SEASON:

1. Stay in frequent contact with my 5 region advisors, division director and national women’s supervisor.
2. Attend women’s OET clinics at-- Mt. Shasta in NorCal region, Snow Summit in Southern CA region, and possibly Arizona region (a regular OET clinic or women’s)
3. Mentor at least one woman for her OET training to become a TI
4. Encourage women in division to become more involved at whatever level they are comfortable with, not only OET but also avalanche, member on local patrol board, becoming an instructor, etc.

ISSUES and RESOLUTIONS:

1. AZ region has not had a women’s clinic in 7-8 years. Resolution: I need to stay in contact with the AZ women’s advisor, encourage, mentor, help with setting up another women’s OET clinic for next season. (I originally had problems with an AZ male OET instructor several years ago, he did not want a separate women’s clinic, but the women’s clinic prevailed.
