I am working on the National ID Committee to improve the design of the on-line ID course and to update the Instructor Development Instructor Manual. The committee is also working on an Instructor Trainer Guidelines mini-presentation for the NSP web site. We completed the update of the ID textbook "Training The Adult Learner" which should be posted on-line soon. We also completed a revision of the NSP Continuing Education Manual which is now called "Instructor Skills Review" and is available for download on the NSP website for all instructors.
