SEASON HIGHLIGHTS — total classes — total participants

Feb. 2018--Attended women's clinic at Sunrise Resort, AZ. Second women's clinic to be held there, I attended first clinic there in 2010. Approx. 10 attendees, 2 OET instructors including myself, held one all day class. Because of this clinic, I was able to find someone willing to volunteer at AZ region women's program advisor.

March 2018--Attended Squaw Women's Summit for 3 days, taught 1 all day and 2 1/2 day toboggan clinics, participated in a short beacon search exercise, attended an NSP meeting, promoted NSP through maintaining a table with information and answering questions. 19 NSP ladies attended all or part of the summit, most took at least one sled clinic our of 3 offered, all attended at least one ski clinic.

Planned visit to Southern CA region and women's clinic was cancelled due to lack of snow.

Feb. 2018--Attended, assisted and taught at ESR Heavenly Resort women's clinic. 11 attended, plus 4 toboggan instructors, all attended 1/2 day toboggan and 1/2 day ski lesson.
