**SEASON HIGHLIGHTS TO DATE** – total classes – total participants  
4 classes of Refresher: Dodge Ridge 17 students, Bear Mtn 74 students, Soda Springs 7 students and Northstar 41 students. Total of 139 students.

New Class approval Patrolling 101. Potential to double OEC revenue in the next fiscal year.

**SEASON GOALS:**

Create new registration procedures that the IORs can follow. Train the IORs to use the new procedures and to check enrollment forms as they are turned in.

Reinstate the patrols that have participated in the past.

**ISSUES and RESOLUTIONS:**

**Issues:**

1. New registration process instituted by the state this year has reduced the participation from 9 patrols to 4 this season. 11 OEC classes participated last year to none this year.
2. Many IORs are not checking enrollment forms for completeness, as a result near half of forms are not complete and students are not registered.
3. Three patrols did not turn in registration forms until end of class.

**Resolutions:**

1. Met with The Academy in October and new registration procedures were created to be implemented in November, unfortunately the changes were too late to be useful for this season.
2. Work with IOR's to show the importance of checking forms as they are turned in.
3. Create a calendar to show due dates for the different steps of the registration process.
