**SEASON GOALS:**

1. Increase number of ID Instructors, ideally 1 per patrol. This would improve access to ID courses.
2. Increase collaboration with FWD Program Supervisors to overcome obstacles to getting instructors through the pipeline
3. Improve understanding of the Mentoring Program. NSP has identified this as an issue for the instructor programs for all disciplines

**ISSUES and RESOLUTIONS:**

1. Increase number of ID instructors
  - a. Working with ID Region Administrators and PRs to identify appropriate ID instructor candidates.
  - b. Coordinating training for up to 3 new ID instructors in MLR and ESR
2. Increase collaboration with FWD Program Supervisors.
  - a. Sent email with contact information for all ID Regional Administrators
  - b. Fielding questions about ID program and ICE
3. Improve understanding of Mentoring Program.
  - a. Make this the focus of the ICE in September
  - b. Asked ID Regional Administrators to focus on this at any training done
