



## Associate Join Process

### Step 1

The new Associate will need to go to [www.nsp.org](http://www.nsp.org) and click on the link that says “Member Sign In”. They will then click on the “Create Account” button at the top of the screen. The Associate will continue to fill in the required fields and click “Save” in the bottom right corner of the screen. If you are a returning Candidate, Patroller, Host member, Associate, or Alumni member from an inactive status looking to join a patrol please do not create a new account.
